

The purpose of the Rollover Neighborhood Association Fund grant program is to build community and to help develop sustained engagement from membership in neighborhood associations. Grant recipients have until June 30, 2019, to complete their projects.

Neighborhood Signs

A handful of NAs have been asking about replacing faded, damaged or missing signs that welcome people to your neighborhoods. Our Streets Department is working on an assessment of the 59 neighborhood signs around Bend to determine which ones need to be replaced. The assessment should be completed in early March.

Once the assessment is completed, we will have a better idea of how many signs need to be replaced and what the cost may be. It is also an opportunity to consider the need to update the design standards to a color and shape that better tolerate the weather and are less expensive to replace.



For those NAs interested in replacing their neighborhood signs, please wait until the Streets Department's assessment has been completed. That could keep you from spending money on producing new signs that might have a new design standard in the near future.

Applications Open for Juniper Ridge Advisory Board

The City is accepting applications for the <u>Juniper Ridge Management</u> <u>Advisory Board</u>. The board is a temporary committee appointed by the City Council and tasked with determining next steps for the 500-acre City owned industrial-zoned site known as Juniper Ridge.

Applicants with expertise in the areas of real estate, finance, industrial land development, economic development, business, and related fields are encouraged to apply. Up to two of the seven appointed members may reside outside of Bend City limits. At least one appointee must reside within the Boyd Acres Neighborhood Association.



Applications will be accepted until 5 p.m. on Friday, March 1. To apply for the advisory board, go to: www.bendoregon.gov/committees.

Budget Updates

Here are your updated balances as of January 8, 2019. They include a payment of \$54.23 for the NA liability insurance. We were able to have that payment hit at the start of the fiscal year this year, instead of the end of the year (as in years past). This change will help you incorporate the expense into your budgeting early on, instead of getting a surprise at the end of the year when your balance is low.
