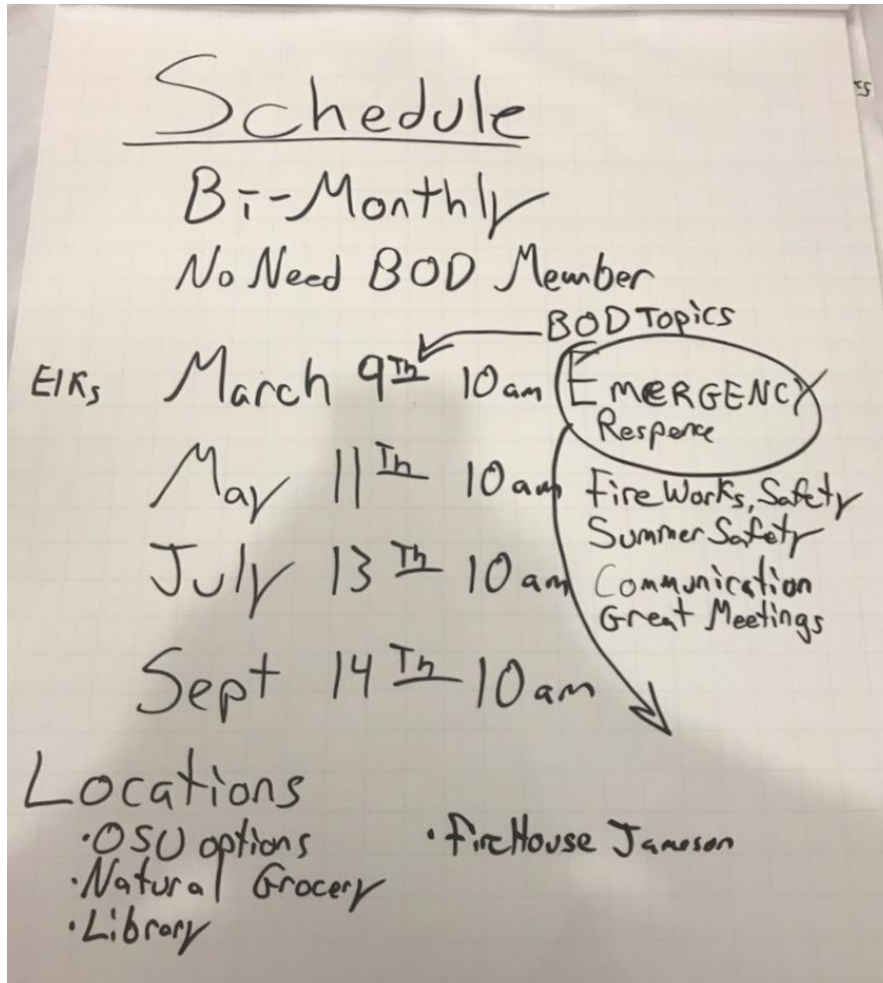
This is accomplished by:
